

BANDING OF WILD DUCKS IN SOUTH-EASTERN QUEENSLAND DURING 1957

In February and March of 1957, 186 wood ducks, *Chenonetta jubata* (Latham), were banded at Stapylton, near Beenleigh, and from May to October 270 black ducks, *Anas superciliosa rogersi* Mathews, and two grey teal, *Anas gibberifrons gracilis* Buller, at St. Lucia and Seventeen Mile Rocks, Brisbane area.

Recoveries (18.3 per cent.) from February 1957 to December 1963 are recorded in detail below. Many of the wood ducks remained on the trapping site up to a month after banding and some had travelled as far afield as Casino, northern New South Wales. A recovery from Yorklea, via Casino, had been banded only two days previously. The farthest recovery was from Ardlethan in the Riverina District of New South Wales over three years later, whilst after a similar period a band was retaken at Lamington, less than 30 miles from the banding site. Six black ducks were retrapped on the banding sites four months later; others had moved in that time at least as far as Newcastle, New South Wales. The farthest northern recovery was at Bogantungan, central Queensland, and to the south at Tarlo, near Goulburn in New South Wales. Two bands when recovered were almost five years old.

During 1958, Departmental banding activities were transferred to other localities within Queensland, and results will be recorded and discussed later.

For each record, the first line is the basic banding data, subsequent lines the recovery data.
